ARTHUR PEACOCKE GRADUATE STUDENTSHIP IN SCIENCE AND RELIGION

Following a generous gift in memory of the late Arthur Peacocke, Exeter College is offering a Scholarship for a graduate student wishing to undertake study or research on the relationships between the sciences and religion in the Faculty of Theology.

The Scholarship covers full University and College fees plus £12,940 living allowance p.a. and will be tenable from 1 October 2008 for a maximum of three years. It is a condition of the Scholarship that the recipient remains at Exeter College, Oxford, for the duration of his or her course.

Candidates should have already been accepted (or be in the process of applying) into the University of Oxford onto the Science and Religion course before applying for this Scholarship. Application is by Scholarship Application Form including at least two academic references, one of which should be from your current tutor/supervisor, to:
