# Exeter College Scarf by Christine Boggis

## Size

Width: 22cm Length: 180cm

# You will need

Rowan Big Wool 100% Merino wool (approx 80m per 100g) 3 x 100g balls in 008 Black (A) 2 x 100g balls in 079 Pantomime (B) 10mm needles Large-eyed, blunt-ended needle for weaving in ends Note: Yarn amounts are based on average requirements and are approximate.

# **Tension**

9 sts and 18 rows to 10cm square over garter stitch (every row knit). *Use larger or smaller needles if necessary to obtain correct tension.* 

# **Abbreviations**

k = knit
rep = repeat
sl = slip stitch: insert your right-hand needle into the stitch as if to knit, but just
slip it from the left-hand to the right-hand needle without knitting it
sts = stitches

### Scarf

Using A, cast on 160 sts. **Row 1:** Knit. **Row 2:** Sl1, k to end. Rep rows 1 and 2 three more times (8 rows in total). \*\*Break A and join in B. Rep rows 1 and 2 four times (8 rows in total). Break B and join in A. Rep rows 1 and 2 four times (8 rows in total). Rep from \*\* once more. Cast off in A.

# To finish

Use a large-eyed, blunt-ended needle to weave in any loose ends.
