FIRE ORDERS

IF YOU DISCOVER A FIRE

- 1. Sound the alarm by operating a 'break glass' unit
- 2. Attack the fire with the appliances provided, but only if you are sure that you will not thereby expose yourself or others to danger.(**Escape is your Priority**)
- 3. Leave the building by the shortest route and make your way directly to the Lodge and inform the Porter that there is a fire
- 4. Report to the assembly point which is in the Chapel.

ON HEARING THE ALARM

- 1. Leave the building by the shortest route
- 2. Close all doors (and if you can do so safely, the windows) behind you.
- 3. If you see any **Signs of Fire** during your escape go directly to the Lodge and report to the Porter where and what you seen.
- 4. Report to the assembly point which is in the Chapel
- DO NOT stop to collect your personal belongings
- DO NOT re-enter any building for any reason until authorised to do so by Fire Officer, College Officer or other person in authority.

FIRE PRECAUTIONS

- A. Take every precaution to avoid creating a fire risk.
- B. Make sure you always know the means of escape from any room you may be in on College Premises.
- C. Make sure you always know which extinguisher to use for every type of of fire, and be sure you know how to operate them all.
- D. NEVER move an extinguisher from its designated place, or use it other than in an emergency.
- E. NEVER tamper with fire alarm equipment or **Prop Fire Doors Open.**
- F. ALWAYS respond to a fire alarm as though it were genuine.
