Jardine Foundation Graduate Scholarships

Exeter College is delighted to be one of the four Oxford Colleges which is able to nominate candidates to the Jardine Foundation for assessment for the Foundation's Graduate Scholarship programme. These Scholarships, which are for graduate study in any discipline starting in October 2022, cover Course Fees and maintenance costs.

The successful candidate will:

- be an applicant to the University of Oxford for admission to a graduate degree (in any subject) starting in the academic year 2022–2023, who has, by the Jardine Foundation's deadline for nominations (which is expected to be in February or March of 2022), been offered a place at Oxford University to read for that graduate degree;
- be resident in any of the countries or territories in which Jardine Matheson Group has significant business interests, which include Cambodia, mainland China, Hong Kong, Indonesia, Malaysia, Myanmar, the Philippines, Singapore, Taiwan, Thailand, Vietnam;
- meet any other criteria laid down by the Jardine Foundation;
- become a member of Exeter College and commit to remaining at Exeter College for the duration of their course.

How to apply

You should apply for your graduate course as early as practicable, and certainly no later than the [relevant January deadline](#). In order to ensure consideration by Exeter College as a potential nomination for the Jardine Foundation Graduate Scholarship you should state Exeter College as your [preferred college](#) on your graduate application form. Exeter College reserves the right to nominate any offer-holder who the College considers best fulfils the requirements of the Jardine Foundation.

Suitably-qualified applicants will be contacted in February or March of 2022 and invited to fill up an application form for the Scholarship. Candidates who do not submit the application form by the deadline specified by the College will not be considered for the Scholarship. Candidates will be selected by the College from amongst these applicants, in accordance with guidance from the Jardine Foundation, and recommended to the Jardine Foundation's selection committee. The decision of whether or not to offer a Scholarship is made by the Jardine Foundation.
