Mary Frances Cairncross Scholarship

Following a generous benefaction, Exeter College seeks to elect to the Mary Frances Cairncross Scholarship from among students who are ordinarily resident in an economically-disadvantaged country (see below), who have not previously studied overseas, and who also have an offer of admission to study for a graduate degree at the University of Oxford starting in the academic year 2022–23.

Where a suitable candidate is identified, the Scholarship will be awarded in conjunction with an Oxford University Clarendon Fund award, and together these awards will usually fund Course Fees and a grant to cover living expenses.

The Scholarship is awarded for one year in the first instance, and will be renewable for the remaining years of fee liability, subject to satisfactory academic progress being made.

Candidates must be applicants to the University of Oxford for admission to a graduate degree and should apply for any other University Scholarship for which they are eligible. The successful candidate must become a member of Exeter College, commit to remaining at Exeter College for the duration of their degree course, and sign an undertaking to return to their home country if possible for at least part of their subsequent career.

The Scholarship is open to students who have not previously studied outside their country of residence and who are ordinarily resident in one of the countries which receives official development assistance from the Development Assistance Committee (DAC) of the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD). These countries are defined as:
