Exonian Graduate Scholarships

Through the generosity of former students of Exeter College, the College seeks to elect up to two Exonian Graduate Scholars from among students who have been awarded a UK Research Council Studentship to study for a DPhil at Oxford University.

Where suitable candidates are identified, each Scholarship will be awarded in conjunction with an Oxford University-awarded UK Research Council Studentship, and together these awards will fund all Course Fees, and a grant to cover living expenses for the DPhil degree.

The successful candidate will:

- be an applicant to the University of Oxford for admission to a graduate degree
- for awards starting in 2019, have an offer of a place to study for a DPhil in one of the Departments in the Mathematical, Physical and Life Sciences Division or one of the Departments in the Medical Sciences Division of the University
- be awarded a UK Research Council Studentship by the University of Oxford;
- become a member of Exeter College, and commit to remaining at Exeter College for the duration of their course.

How to apply

There is no separate application process for this Scholarship; you simply need to apply for your graduate course by the [relevant January deadline](#).

We will consider all eligible applicants to Oxford for this Scholarship, regardless of whether or not you state Exeter College as your [preferred college](#) on your graduate application form. If we offer you this Scholarship we will also offer you a place at Exeter College, which will take the place of any earlier college offer you may have.
