Nicholas Frangiscatos Scholarship in Byzantine and post-Byzantine Studies

The College seeks to elect a Nicholas Frangiscatos Scholar from among students who have an offer of admission to study for a DPhil with research in the field of Byzantine or post-Byzantine Studies, in one of the following Faculties at the University of Oxford: History, Medieval and Modern Languages, Oriental Studies or Theology.

Where a suitable candidate is identified, the Scholarship will be awarded in conjunction with an Oxford University Clarendon Fund award, and together these awards will fund all Course Fees and a grant to cover living expenses. Otherwise, it will be awarded as a standalone Scholarship, in which case its value will be up to that of the UK's Arts & Humanities Research Council stipend (£14,777 in 2018-19).

The Scholarship is awarded for one year in the first instance, and will be renewable for up to two further years subject to satisfactory academic progress being made.

The successful candidate must become a member of Exeter College and commit to remaining at Exeter College for the duration of their course.

How to apply

To apply for this Scholarship, you need to apply for your graduate course via the University of Oxford graduate application process by the [relevant January deadline](#). To assist the College in assessing applicants for this Scholarship, you should state Exeter College as your [preferred college](#) on your graduate application form. In parallel with submitting your application for graduate study to the University of Oxford, you should write to the Admissions Administrator at Exeter College (admissions@exeter.ox.ac.uk), no later than 31 January 2019, to request that, should you be successful in gaining an offer of a place to study at the University of Oxford, your application might be considered for this Scholarship.

The successful candidate will be contacted by the College. Candidates who have not been contacted by the end of June should assume that, unfortunately, they have not been successful.
