## **The Bodh Raj Sawhny Memorial Scholarship**

The Bodh Raj Sawhny Memorial Trust, New Delhi, India has established a Scholarship in memory of Bodh Raj Sawhny, who attended Exeter College in 1902, reading Civil Law.

Exeter College seeks to elect to the Bodh Raj Sawhny Memorial Scholarship from amongst candidates who are normally resident in India and who have an offer of admission to Oxford University and a place at Exeter College to read for the BCL degree in Law.

This Scholarship is worth Rupees one lakh (Rs. 1, 00,000/-).

The successful candidate must become a member of Exeter College and commit to remaining at Exeter College for the duration of their BCL degree.

### **How to apply**

We will consider all eligible applicants to Oxford for this Scholarship, regardless of whether or not you state Exeter College as your preferred college on your graduate application form. If we offer you this Scholarship we will also offer you a place at Exeter College, which will take the place of any earlier college offer you may have. There is no separate application process for this Scholarship; you simply need to apply for your graduate course by the [relevant January deadline](#).
